(Staff: Pastor Troy George; S. S. Committee)

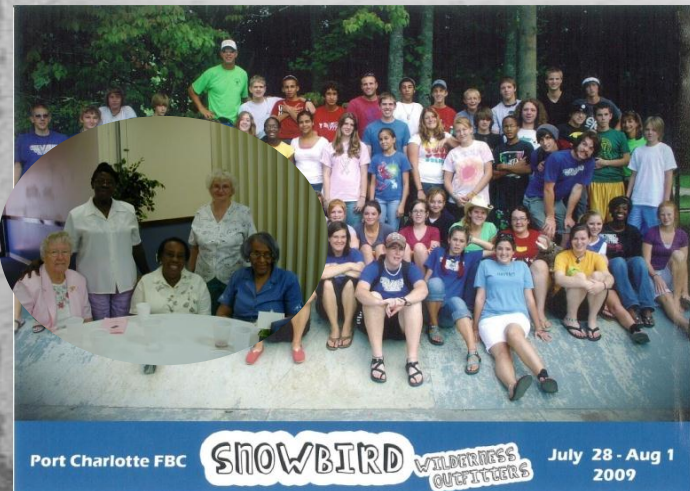
