6:30pm during the summer, for Wednesday evening activities; birth through kindergarten

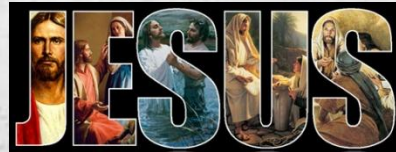


### **Other Ministry Events:**

## Goals of the Preschool Ministry

To introduce each child to God, the Father, and His Son, Jesus Christ. To help them understand God's love for them and that He sent His son, Jesus, to die for them. We will work with parents teaching Bible-truths to prepare children to have a personal relationship with Jesus.



To provide a safe, secure, loving environment for children where parents can feel comfortable leaving their child.

To help preschoolers feel a sense of belonging to their Church Family and to ensure each child feels welcomed and wanted.

For each child to know that God is real and that a personal relationship with Him gives meaning to life.

To provide Godly men and women who are adequately trained to serve as positive role models.



## What you can Expect Each Week

- Warm, bright, inviting, well equipped rooms
- Rooms cleaned weekly
- Toys sanitized weekly
- Every baby will have a clean sheet and blanket
- Variety of activities that offer stimulation for both mental and spiritual growth
- Snack offered during transition time between services
- Bible-truths taught through age appropriate Bible stories, games, crafts, activities, and music
- Loving, caring, well-trained adults to care for your child while you attend a Worship Service or Bible Study/Small Group



## Safety is Our Priority

- It is a Church requirement for all adults to have a background and reference check completed before caring for children
- There are always two or more teachers in each classroom
- Each child is assigned a security number and the parents are issued an ID Tag ~ you must stop at the front window to receive your child's ID Tag each week
- Children are released from a classroom *after* the ID Tag has been given to the caregiver
- Display boxes in the Worship Center clearly indicate your child's number, if you are needed for assistance
- It is Church policy that parents of preschoolers remain on campus while children are in our care



## Reminders for Parents

Please remember to bring enough diapers, wipes, bottles with preparation instructions, and an extra change of clothing each time your child is in our care.

**Please have your child's name, clearly marked, on all belongings.**
